

Sandbridge Beach Civic League Scholarship

Application Criteria

Selection will be based on educational achievement, community service, extra-curricular activities, leadership and essay. The SBCL is awarding 4 scholarships this year. \$2000; \$1500; \$1000 and \$500

Eligibility:

- Graduating senior from an accredited high school or home school program
- Applicant's family must be current members of the Sandbridge Beach Civic League and the applicant must be a full time resident of Sandbridge. (Boundaries are Dam Neck base on the North, Atlantic Ocean on the East, the Back Bay Refuge on the South and Bay Bay, North Bay, the canals and to a point 2000 feet West of Sandpiper Road on Sandbridge Road onn the West)
- Applicant must enter college, university, trade or technical school as a full time student within the following year.

Requirements / Conditions:

1. Application must be completed in full and submitted to Mike Maloney, SBCL Scholarship Chair, at 304 Teal Crescent no later than 6pm on Friday May 1, 2020. The application packet includes the application, official school transcript, written essay and two letters of reference. One letter from a Sandbridge resident neighbor or friend and one from a teacher, advisor or counselor. No incomplete or late applications will be accepted.
2. An academic resume may accompany the application to fully show all awards, experience and activities.
3. Applicant should be fully aware that the award will be paid directly to the recipients' college, university, trade or technical school.
4. In the event no applicant meets these requirements, no scholarship will be awarded this year.
